PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

Approval of November 18, 2024, Meeting Minutes: Terry Tomsheck motioned to approve. Terry Kimmet seconded the motion, motion carried.

- 1. Consider the purchase of a new County Road Department 1 ton pickup to replace Lloyd's existing 2019 F350. Quotes were as follows:
 - a. New Ford quote is \$64,068
 - b. New Chevy Quote is \$64,070

The Road Superintendent preferred to go with the Ford as the snow blade would fit it and it has a twin I beam suspension. If the purchase is approved the money would come out of Road Fund 2110. Terry Tomsheck motioned to approve the purchase of the New Ford for \$64,068. This price is before the trade in value of the current 2019 F350. Terry Kimmet seconded the motion, motion carried.

2. Discussion of purchasing a new 2025 325G Skid Steer Loader and Artic Snow Pusher from RDO for \$92,200.00. Torgerson's quote is \$92,414.58. These are both through SourceWell

Contract Number 011723-JDC. If approved, it would come out of the General Capital Improvement Fund 4020. Terry Kimmet motioned to approve. Terry Tomsheck seconded the motion, motion carried.
